- ✓ Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- ✓ Ability to foster a collaborative and effective working relationship with others.
- ✓ Ability to read and interpret professional literature and reports.
- ✓ Ability to utilize and implement relevant technology.

Responsibilities

- ✓ Courses to be taught include (1) Science 8, (2) Physical Science, (1) Physics, and (1) Chemistry class.
- ✓ Follow lesson plans and provide appropriate individual/group instruction to accommodate the needs of all students.
- ✓ Communicate regularly with parents outside of the normal classroom day by means of newsletters, notes, telephone calls, and conferences.
