Job Summary: To provide speech, language, and oral/motor diagnostic services to students.

Qualifications and other requirements – To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential function satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.

- ✓ Master's degree in Speech and Language Pathology.
- ✓ A minimum of 60 semester or equivalent hours of academic credit in normal aspects of human communication, development thereof, and clinical techniques for evaluation and management of speech and language disorders.
- ✓ Has a valid Michigan License in Speech Pathology.
- ✓ Ability to communicate effectively both orally and in writing.
- ✓ Ability to foster a collaborative and effective working relationship with others.
- ✓ Ability to read and interpret professional literature and reports.
- ✓ Ability to utilize and implement relevant technology.

Essential functions of the job include but are not limited to the following:

- ✓ Reliable, regular, and punctual on-site attendance is required to perform the essential functions, duties, and responsibilities of a therapist.
- ✓ Schedule and conduct all REEDS and IEPT meetings of speech and language students.
- ✓ Provide screening, identification, assessment, diagnosis, treatment, intervention, and follow-up services for disorders of speech and language.
- ✓ Provide training/support to staff and parents of individuals with speech, voice, and language communication disabilities.
- ✓ Develop and establish effective augmentative and alternative communication techniques and strategies, including selecting, prescribing, and dispensing of aids and devices, and training individuals in their use.
- ✓ To work with adaptive devices.
- ✓ Maintain effective communication and relationships with students, parents, and school personnel.
- ✓ Maintain accurate and timely records.
- ✓ Demonstrate professional conduct and exhibit professional growth.
- ✓ Manage a safe and comfortable learning environment.
- ✓ Inform supervisor of student's progress and programmatic concerns.
- ✓ Comply with school district policies and procedures.
- ✓ Effectively participate in meetings, committees, staffings, and other required district and building activities in a positive manner.
- ✓ Effectively plan and organize duties as well as personal work environment.
- ✓ Comply with Medicaid billing.
- ✓ Perform other duties as assigned.

Physical requirements of the job – While performing the duties of this job, the employee is frequently required to stand and talk or hear and sometimes walk and sit. While performing the duties of this job, the employee may occasionally push or lift up to 50 lbs. such as boxes of books and AV carts. The employee is directly responsible for safety, well-being, or work output of other people.
