RETURN TO LEARN PLAN

At Chikaming Elementary, we believe that nothing can replace the learning that happens in school as relationships with teachers, staff, and students are built. However, we recognize the challenges of in-person learning during a global pandemic.

The social-emotional health of our students is our highest priority and will remain the focus of all learning at Chikaming (both in-person and remotely). We continue to believe that too much screen time is not healthy for students (or adults) and that there is great learning that takes place through play. Our remote learning plans are designed with these concepts in mind - working to minimize screen time and maximize the fun in learning!

If we are required to go to virtual learning exclusively, our remote learning plan will be a blend of hands-on/paper packet and online experiences. Families and teachers will communicate through our online learning platform - SeeSaw. This is where lesson videos will be housed, and you will find assignment information. Students will continue to be provided with paper/hard copies of many work assignments for completion on a weekly basis. Students will be assigned times to meet with school staff virtually both independently and in small groups throughout the week. Students and families will be expected to log on to our online learning platform daily and to use this tool (and others) to communicate with teachers throughout each school day.
